MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: United States Army Garrison Kaiserslautern (USAGK) Command Policy Letter #16-Off Post Training

1. Applicability. This policy applies to all Soldiers, Tenant Units and DA Civilians stationed or training in the United States Army Garrison Kaiserslautern (USAGK) Community. This policy implements the NATO Status of Forces Agreement (SOFA Article 45 and as amended by Article 22); Article 28 of the German Supplementary Agreement(SA); and the USAREUR Regulation 350-22, Training Maneuver and Field Training Exercise Rights in Germany, as it concerns the rights and obligations of the U.S. Forces when training on German land outside U.S. facilities; Major Training Areas (MTAs)(USAREUR Reg 350-1); or Local Training Areas (LTAs) (USAREUR Reg 350-1).

2. This policy establishes the administrative and notification procedures for tenant units and DA Civilians in the USAGK Community that have been approved by USAREUR/7A to conduct off installation training.

3. Tenant units will send their signed and approved USAREUR/7A Maneuver Rights AE Form 350-22E-R (para 6) to the USAGK DPTMS and the 21<sup>st</sup> TSC G3 Training, notifying both commands of the off installation training that will be conducted no later than four weeks prior to the training to be conducted.

4. Units and DA Civilians conducting the approved off installation training will provide the USAGK DPTMS and the 21<sup>st</sup> TSC G3 Training grid coordinates and a map depicting the location of the training that will be conducted.

5. The USAGK PMO will then notify the local Polizei and the 569<sup>th</sup> USFPs. Additionally, the USAGK PAO will notify German authorities about the approved U.S. Forces maneuver and exercise activities that will be conducted in the area and off of an installation.


6. The notification of the local Polizei, the 569<sup>th</sup> USFPS and German authorities will also include the grid coordinates and map depicting the location of the training that will be conducted. Notification of the local Polizei and German authorities will be no less than 3 weeks prior to execution of the training to be conducted.

7. Under no circumstances will US personnel, with the exception of those allowed under the NATO SOFA (e.g., military police), be permitted to brandish weapons outside recognized military training areas. This includes Quick Reaction Forces (QRF), Installation Reaction Forces (IRF), or training events (i.e., patrolling, land navigation, marches, weapons immersion training, Survival, Evasion, Resistance, Escape (SERE) Training, etc.).
