

Bad Weather and Hazardous Road Conditions

In the event of rain, snow, icy roads, accumulated leaves on the road surface, and eventually strong winds, one must slow down, steer smoothly and never brake heavily.

On cobblestone roads, the braking distance is much longer, and the risk of skidding is far greater than on rough asphalt roads.

On a rutted road surface, beware of aquaplaning.....
